TRAVELING TO/FROM ITALY – USEFUL INFORMATION

To ease your pre-arrival and stay at Casali di Casole we put together the most recent and available info, procedures, and steps to take in order to enter Italy and travel back home at the end of your stay according to the Covid-19's regulations applied on travels.

The websites and links we are providing in this document are subject to changes, so we suggest you to keep monitoring the situation while getting closer to your departure date to Italy in order to get the most recent regulations and procedures.

The first part of this document is a detailed list of steps that passengers need to comply with for the entry in Italy, each one corresponding to a website and/or registrations that need to be done along with instructions on how to correctly complete them.

At the end of the document there is a quick recap that you can check to make sure all is done before your departure.

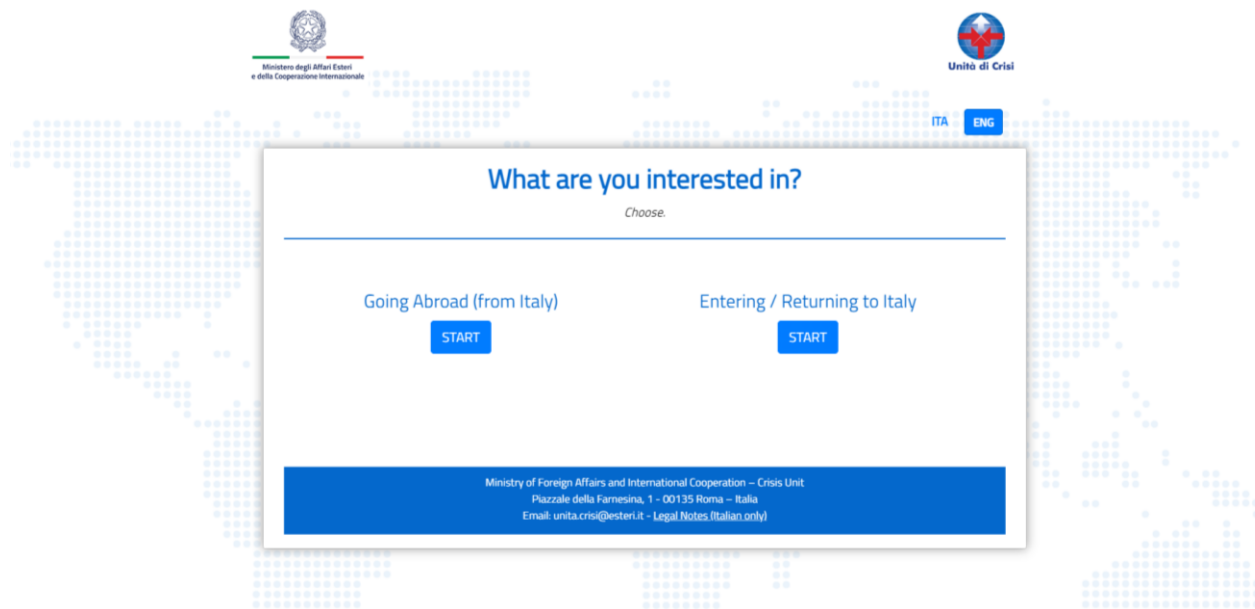
Considering the confidential information you are requested to submit, it is highly recommended to proceed with the various registrations on your own but for any doubts or questions the Concierge Team of Casali di Casole is at your disposal.

ARRIVAL TO ITALY:

#1. For any info about your arrival we suggest you to take as first step a survey that the Italian Government supplies on the following website: https://infocovid.viaggiasesicuri.it/index_en.html



Click on “Entering/Returning to Italy” and answer all the questions. Kindly note, in the section “**Where have you been in the 14 days prior to your attempt to enter Italy?**” you can select more than 1 country in case you visited another State other than your country of origin before your arrival in Italy.

The survey will give you the first info about requirements and necessary steps to enter Italy from your origin country.

VERY IMPORTANT: verify on the survey result:

- You can enter Italy for any reasons.
If not, the website indicates the categories that are allowed to travel to Italy coming specifically from your country of origin. You need to provide one of the listed reasons on the website indicated in next step (see #2 on this document).
- If you must undergo an antigen or molecular test prior to your departure to Italy and within how many hours before your flight so that you can schedule it at the best in time by your trusted lab/doctor.
- If you are requested or not to do a quarantine of 10 days followed by a molecular/antigenic test at the end of the 10-day self-isolation.
Quarantine is applied only to a number of origin countries.
If yours is one of them, please continue reading and check in the below section of the survey if you fall in any of the options of exemptions to the quarantine.

Among the exemptions, the following ones can be applied to travelers coming from Canada, USA, Japan, United Arab Emirates etc.

A) “Passengers of “Covid-tested” flights, as defined by the Minister of Health with Order of November 23 2020. **For further information on “Covid-tested” flights, kindly contact your airline.**

Falling in this case and following the instructions of your airline to be able to board on these flights you are allowed to travel to Italy and not self-isolate upon arrival.

B) Additionally, following the new Ordinance of 18 June 2021 from Minister of Health, valid until July 30th, entries to Italy with green certifications issued by your local health authorities **from Canada, Japan and the United States are allowed.**

Possessing a Green Pass (or Green Certificate) of your own Country of origin, showing proof that you have either:

- **been vaccinated against COVID-19** with an EMA authorized vaccine and you have completed the prescribed vaccination cycle since at least fourteen (14) days;
- **received a negative result of a molecular or antigenic test** carried out in the 48 hours before your arrival;
- **recovered from COVID-19** and you are no longer under prescription of self-isolation.

You can enter Italy without having to self-isolate and get tested after self-isolating.

#2. Mandatory for any and each traveler to enter Italy is the registration on the Passenger Locator Form platform.

Before entering Italy, passengers are required to complete a specific **digital Passenger Locator Form (dPLF)**.

Passenger requirements

Starting from 24 May 2021, all passengers wishing to enter Italy will be required to complete a dPLF **before entering national territory**, following the instructions below:

- go to the website <https://app.euplf.eu/#/>
- follow the wizard to access the dPLF
- select ‘Italy’ as the destination country
- register on the website by creating a personal account with username and password (required only the first time you use the website)
- confirm the account via the link sent to the email address provided (required only the first time you use the website)
- complete and send the dPLF following the wizard.

Once the form has been sent, passengers receive the dPLF in PDF and as a QR Code at the email address entered during registration, which must be shown directly from a smartphone (in digital format) when boarding. Alternatively, passengers can print a copy of the dPLF to show when boarding.

The dPLF must be sent before boarding. The seat number assigned on the flight can however be edited at any time.

One form must be completed for each adult passenger; accompanied minors can be registered on the form of the accompanying adult.

In the case of unaccompanied minors, the dPLF must be completed by the parent or legal guardian before departure.

In case a family is traveling together, only one member of the family will have to complete the PLF. The details of the rest of the family members should then be included in this PLF. The same applies to groups travelling together. Only one person from the group should complete the PLF and the details of the rest of the group members should then be included in this PLF. Note that this applies only to families and groups of people that will take part in the same activities and stay at the same place during their visit to the destination country.

The digital Passenger Locator Form replaces the declaration referred to in Art. 50, paragraph 1 of the Prime Ministerial Decree of 2 March 2021. In exceptional cases, namely exclusively the lack of the required technology, passengers may complete a [paper based form](#) available at this address:

Please note that the Border Officers in Italy may request that you fill out the paper-based self-statement upon arrival. If you want to fill it in prior to arrival for your convenience, please download it from the link above.

#3. Locally our region, TOSCANA, requires any and each visitor to register himself on the dedicated Health Authority portal:

You can choose English from the menu on the top right of the page and proceed filling in the fields. All fields are mandatory. Necessary steps to properly fill in the form:

- It is necessary to put a tick in the below box:

The page refreshes and you are requested to insert your passport's details.

- Immediately below there is this box:

IMPORTANT:

Click on this box ONLY if you can be exempted from the self-isolation quarantine according to the list options you found completing the survey of the #1 step on this document e.g. **A) Covid tested flights.**

Clicking in the box the full list of exemptions appears and you can select the one that can be applied to your case.

e.g. entries realized through "covid-tested" flights, in accordance with the ordinance issued by the Health Ministry on 23/11/2020 and following modifications

- If you are falling into the exemption **B) entries with Green Certificate/ Pass** DO NOT click on the Trip section saying "I fall within the exemption.." but insert your Country of origin and select the first point. "I declare to be in possession of one of the Covid -19 Green certifications..."

Trip I fall within the exemptions provided for by the DPCM 3 December 2020

Foreign country of origin Date of entry into Italy

I declare to be in possession of one of the COVID-19 green certifications issued pursuant to art. 9, paragraph 2, of the decree-law of 22 April 2021, n. 52 and pursuant to EU regulations no. 2021/953 and n. 2021/954, which shows:

Swab

1. anti-SARS-CoV-2 **vaccination occurred**, with certification of the completion of the prescribed vaccination cycle for at least fourteen days
2. **healing from COVID-19 occurred**, with simultaneous cessation of the prescribed isolation following SARS-CoV-2 infection
3. carrying out, in the **forty-eight hours prior** to entry into the national territory, a **rapid or molecular antigen test** with negative results for the SARS-CoV-2 virus

I declare that I am **NOT** in possession of one of the COVID-19 green certifications issued pursuant to art. 9, paragraph 2, of the decree-law of 22 April 2021, n. 52 and pursuant to EU regulations no. 2021/953 and n. 2021/954

If you are requested instead to self-isolate skip this box and select the second point stating "I declare I am **NOT** in possession of one of the Covid-19 Green certification..."

The Health Authority will use the contact details to get in touch with you directly after your arrival and arrange the antigen/molecular test at the end of the self-isolation period.


- The address of our estate that you need to write down in "Domicile" is:

Phone number: 0577 1697801 – this is the Concierge Office phone number.
Mobile: insert the mobile number you will use during your stay in Italy.

At the end of the procedure, you will receive a confirmation email automatically generated by the system.

TRAVEL OUT OF ITALY:

#4. Each Country has its own regulation and procedures to travel back from Italy and they are subjected to numerous changes we cannot regularly be updated with, so our first recommendation is to directly check on your country's Health Department website or with your airline to make sure to have all the proper information.

Putting in the details of your travel, and clicking on Submit, at the bottom right of the page, you can get the requirements for your trip to Italy as well as the ones to travel back home.

Right at the top of the page you can specify if you are taking a "Return", "One way" flight or "Transit" in another country prior to your destination. You can click on the appropriate section to get the most detailed information applied to your own travel.

The list regarding the arrival procedures on this website might be confusing so our recommendation is to do step #1 for this part of your trip as it is clearer and more detailed. Anyhow Traveldoc is helpful to check the regulations applied to your return back home.

IMPORTANT: In case you are requested to undergo an antigen or molecular test prior to your departure to travel back home or to your next destination please, inform the Concierge Team with at least a 7 day-notice so that we can perfectly schedule it according to your specific needs.

As of now all the major Italian airports are organized to locally perform antigen tests right before the departures but if you feel more comfortable in getting the results in advance or you need molecular tests rather than antigen or are requested to have the results in English, we are at complete disposal to arrange the tests in the facilities nearby Casali di Casole for you and your party of guests and can provide you with the related costs and information.
